EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

"When Jesus saw the crowds, he had compassion for them because they were confused and aimless, like sheep without a shepherd. He said to his disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask him to send more workers into his fields.'"

Jesus would die and then be raised from the grave before commissioning his church to go bring in the harvest by following in his steps!

There is no denying that we live in challenging and exciting times, but the Kingdom of God continues to expand here in the Pacific Northwest and around the world. The Holy Spirit is working through God's people and new churches are being born and disciples are being made! This is not a time to hold back and be discouraged or afraid. We have the responsibility to reach and shepherd this next generation with the the gospel! What could be more important or fulfilling than that? As you read this report, I pray that your heart will be stirred into action to find your place in God's plan for the harvest in the Pacific Northwest!



They are currently having dinner parties and building relationships with the hope of beginning public worship services in the Fall of 2024.


EVERYONE SHOULD HAVE A HOME CHURCH

There were additional administrative costs this year due to reorganization & staff changes.






