# A LETTER FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

I've had the privilege of serving with Evergreen for the past three years. Before that, I spent five years with another church planting organization in the Northeast. However, my journey began as a church planter, helping launch churches in the Boston and Pittsburgh metro areas, and I've now been involved in church planting in various capacities for nearly 30 years. I joined the Evergreen staff in 2022 and stepped into the role of Executive Director in January 2023.

While serving as the lead planter of a new church, the organization we partnered with played a vital role in our journey. They helped secure the financial partnerships we needed, provided oversight and accountability, offered coaching that strengthened our ability to fulfill our vision, and surrounded us with a network of fellow planters who felt like family.

Our church plants experienced meaningful early momentum—baptizing hundreds of new believers, growing rapidly in attendance, launching multiple campuses, planting four daughter churches our region, and developing leaders who became elders and staff. But over my 17 years as lead pastor, I also faced significant challenges, including my cancer diagnosis, ongoing health issues, property complications, unexpected staff transitions, and even campus closures.

In those difficult moments, I was deeply grateful for the support of a trusted organization walking alongside me every step of the way.

That experience shapes how we lead Evergreen Network today. I often tell our planters, “You matter more to me than your church plant,” and I truly mean it. We are committed to identifying the right leaders for the unique context of the Pacific Northwest, sharing the responsibility of fundraising, and providing the oversight and support needed until each church becomes self-supporting, self-governing, and multiplying. Just as importantly, we offer a relational network—a family—where leaders are known, cared for, and mentored.

No one does this alone. If your church is looking to multiply its mission through church planting, we can help make the process simple. And if you feel called to plant a church, we'll walk with you every step of the way.
